What is this product?

Type	This product is a Unit Linked Fund.
Strategy	The investment in this Fund should be considered as long-term. The value of your investment will fluctuate according to the performance of the Fund. It invests mainly in growth investments such as equity and equity mutual funds, but also to a lesser extent to bonds and bond mutual funds. Particular emphasis is given to sectors with long-term prospects. There are no performance guarantees attaching to this fund.
Intended Investor	The fund is suitable for investors with a long-term horizon of over 10 years and aims for long-term capital appreciation by holding mostly local and international stocks and to a lesser extent defensive investments (bonds and cash).
Maturity	This fund is open ended.



What are the risks and what do I get in return?



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you. The risk indicator assumes that you keep the product for 20 years.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact the capacity for you to receive a positive return on your investment.
