



### Technology

The building has a state-of-the-art security system, fire protection and fire extinguishing systems, advanced technology structured cabling as well as fiber optics cabling with the ability to connect to all countries of the world for teleconferencing purposes. Modern air conditioning and ventilation systems provide an outstandingly good and healthy environment for the users of the building, whilst at the same time saving energy through heat recovery units and special cooling and heating savings systems. Energy saving is also achieved by the smart shading system installed in the building, which is connected to a central computerized control system that regulates all operations to do with energy, lighting, air conditioning and shading, using

special sensors that recognize the intensity of light and sunlight but also rain, wind intensity and whether it is cloudy or sunny outside.

### Special Features

All the offices have LED lighting with automatic controls and movement sensors, which activate the lights when needed and when the natural light is insufficient, thus further contributing to energy saving whilst maintaining optimal lighting conditions.

### Employee Wellness

A state-of-the-art amphitheatre is situated on the ground floor of the building with a seating capacity for 123 people. The building also has a large modern cafeteria & restaurant, which is available for use by the company's employees and guests.
